Is Windows 7 Better ?

We have been using Windows 7 in store for a few months now, from the first look it's a much slicker and cleaner system. I think people will be pleasantly surprised with Windows 7.

Menus open with lightning speed and there doesn't seem to be the waiting around for programs and menus to open and be available to use.

The display is brighter and fonts look better on screen (you can even custom set these to your own monitor and choose the size of font that's comfortable for you), it's all down to the new High Definition settings of Windows 7.

There are less nagging messages that come up compared with Vista and you can set the level of security if you don't want them at all.

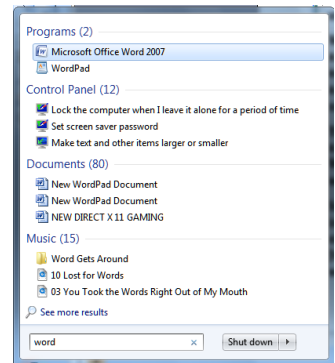
A really useful facility is to make a CD act like a large floppy or USB flash drive so you can save files directly to it straight from Word or any other program.

There's also a new and improved desktop system that allows Windows to be snapped to left and right to allow two Windows to be shown equally on the screen side by side.

Starting Windows 7 takes under a minute even on earlier P4 systems and shuts down equally fast. Click on a program and it's there on screen ready for you.

Your battery should also last a little longer if you use Windows 7 compared with Microsoft Vista.

Searching for anything is much easier and effective in Windows 7. Just type in what you want to find, it will categorize the search by programs , control

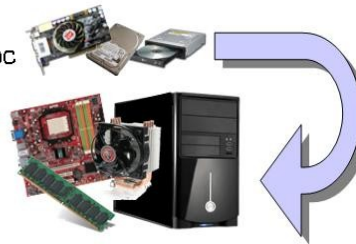

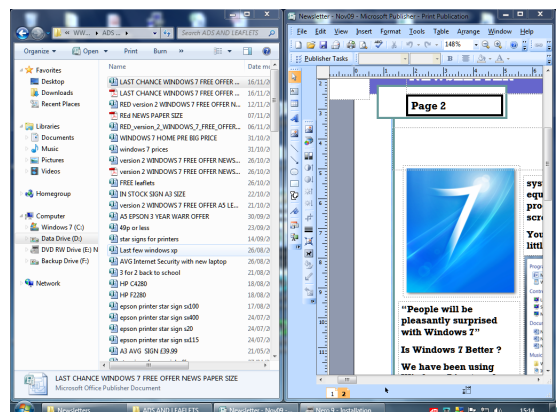

VIRUS REARS ITS UGLY HEAD AGAIN

A WARNING TO EVERYONE

Antivirus2009/2010 is still causing many computers to grind to a halt.

If you get to a screen that states that you need an Anti virus scan the only option would be to reach for the power button on your computer and switch it off.

Generally this isn't recommended as it could cause corruptions on the hard drive but it's the lesser of two evils.

This is a rogue anti-spyware program. It is a clone of Antivirus 2008 - also a rogue, and one that's produced more clones than any other. The list of these clones is long: System Antivirus 2008, Ultimate Antivirus 2008, Vista Antivirus 2008, XP Antivirus 2008 and now **Anti Virus Personal 2010**.

The only prevention we can advise is to stay away from odd looking web sites and from file sharing programs such as LIMEWIRE & BIT TORRENTS.
